


CONT'D ALUMNI SPOTLIGHTS AND CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

I have provided career guidance in schools and organized free oral health awareness sessions in communities. In 2023, with my fellow finalyear students and Dr. Chingwena, we reached around 150 students at Dzikwa Trust. About 80 students received free treatments at Parirenyatwa Group of Hospitals.

I am committed to making a difference with my dental expertise. Empowering young women is crucial for enhancing their potential and benefiting our communities.
